AFFIDAVIT

1. I am a Senior Inspector with the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (RSPCA) Queensland Inc. appointed under the Animal Care and Protection Act 2001.
2. On 3 April 2001 ⁸ Inspector Laurie Stageman allowed me entry to the evidence room at the RSPCA Inspectorate office at Fairfield. He identified to me the property in the room in relation to the matter of Geraldine Fooi Fong Robertson. This property was labeled GR 1 to GR 17. 
