I am amazed at the/lack of communication between you and members of your Department.

A letter from your Chief Executive Dr Rick Symonds dated 21 April was received by me on 24 April 2008 confirming Fiona Ferguson decision to "steal" my valuable pedigreed poodles.

I had always believed in honesty, integrity and justice in the Public Service. The facts I had provided supported my case was totally ignored. How could anyone totally ignore the facts of my case which is and was highly publicised except although I did not believe the allegations made by numerous persons that your office (DPI) and the RSPCA were in collusion, I now have to admit that in view of your Department's decision, that this must be the case. Ms Fiona Ferguson did tell my Lawyer that the decision of

the ~~the~~ Appeal handed in ~~to~~ your Security Officer at the desk at 3.35pm on Friday 28 March would have decision available on Monday 31 March. I guess that it would take your office 3 weeks to have reply typed.

Your action or lack of action did not take into account the total destruction of not only my life, livelihood but also the lives of all my beloved live poodles. I cannot help but wonder how any of you would feel when this sort of "justice" happens to you & your families. Perhaps you will feel the nausous, sick feeling every day, covered in nerve rashes, insommonia, dizzy spells etc... as I had been experiencing since 9/1/08.
